MINUTES OF 1st SHORT-TERM EXCHANGES OF GROUPS OF PUPILS 3rd – 7th April 2017 Dakovo, Croatia

We, as contact persons/organization representatives, report that we have agreed on the following subjects that are carried out, decided or planned jointly about the partnership project.

1. The partners of the KA2 strategic partnership “Understanding and Critical Media Literacy” from Croatia, the Czech Republic, Estonia, Greece, Italy, Romania, Slovakia, Spain and Turkey, have joined the 1st Short-term exchanges of groups of pupils in Dakovo, Croatia, on 3rd – 7th April 2017 that was organized by the Croatian partner. The number of the participants according to the country are shown in the following table:

2. The participants were welcomed by the Croatian school representatives and the instructions about the activities of the meeting were presented.

3. The host school organized the following workshops:

“Mogy platform”

Presentation by the Croatian professor Mirala Šunda (sundamirela@gmail.com) who is creating personalized training programs for individuals or groups. More information about this can be found at www.mogy.me

“The media scene in Croatia”

Presentation by the member of Croatian Journalist Association based in Zagreb which was founded in 1910. The presentation which was followed with discussion was about the current situation regarding mass media in a host country.

4. In addition, each partner prepared one workshop for all participants which was devoted to peer to peer learning activities.

5. Visit to the Town Hall and the Mayor was organized. Then all participants continued with the sightseeing in the town of Dakovo (the Cathedral, Strossmayer´ Museum, the Church of All Saints, Town Museum)

6. A cultural trip to Osijek was organized with the aim to visit the company “Glas Slavonije” – a regional newspaper and TV.

7. Staff members and teachers evaluated the project activities realized in the first school year. The emphasis was put on cooperative work, peer to peer learning, creativity, understanding and team work. We have agreed that mass media can be used as tools or as a content in the lesson plans prepared by each partner. For the future we need to focus more on critical thinking.

8. The Italian student Sara Tosi was awarded for designing the project logo which was chosen in the logo competition.

9. The project partners have discussed the possibility to swap the meetings in Romania and Greece. Depending on the approval of the Estonian National Agency, next meeting will be either in Greece or in Romania in the following dates:

a) In case of organizing next meeting in Greece:

9th – 13th October 2017 (9th arrival day, 13th departure day)

b) In case of organizing next meeting in Romania:

6th – 10th November 2017 (5th arrival, 11th departure)

10. Timetable of the meetings in the second and third year of the project period are as following:

Romania – October 2017- Short-term joint staff training events

Greece – February 2018- Transnational meeting

Turkey – May 2018- Short-term exchanges of groups of pupils

Italy – October 2018- Short-term joint staff training events

Slovakia – March 2019- Transnational meeting

Czech republic– June 2019- Short-term exchanges of groups of pupils + Multiplier event

11. All partners have agreed on completing the following tasks:

a) Each partner will send the copy of invoices, boarding passes, travel tickets and any other relevant documents connected with the first short-term exchanges of groups of pupils in Croatia to the coordinator.

b) Each partner will send the presentations and videos about their countries, towns and organizations to the Greek partner (mariamit@gmail.com) to be uploaded on the project website.

c) Each partner will send the lesson plans to the Estonian coordinator (maris@hiig.edu.ee, milvitikka@hiig.edu.ee) and to the Greek partner (mariamit@gmail.com) to be uploaded on the project website.

DEADLINE: 21st April 2017

d) The Estonian coordinator will prepare amendments to the contracts due to the change of the places of two transnational meetings.

e) The Estonian coordinator will open the etwinning project at <https://www.etwinning.net/en/pub/index.htm>. Each partner will make sure that they have etwinning accounts so that we can develop project activities on etwinning as well.

g) Each partner will make a list of at least 3 suggestions – lesson topics which they want to implement and prepare in the following school years. Two lesson plans will be prepared in the school year 2017/2018 and one lesson plan will be prepared in the school year 2018/2019. h) Each partner is obliged to finish questionnaire survey about mass media with at least 50 responses and send their countries results to the Slovakian partner (lmikulova@gmail.com) Each partner can collect data either on paper or via google form.
