Explain why you cannot help.</p>
<p>You are a homeless person and you decide to enter a public building, to ask for help from the authorities.</p>	<p>You are the receptionist of the Town Hall. A homeless person, dirty and drunk enters to ask for help to find a house. Listen to the requests and respond in suitable ways.</p>
<p>You are a homeless person, sitting quietly on a park bench, reading a newspaper somebody left behind. You've just seen the photo of your distant relative and read the news he/she won a lottery.</p>	<p>You are a young boy or girl, who is angry with the world and on the lookout for trouble. You see a tramp on a park bench and decide to be difficult with him or her. Approach the tramp and find ways of venting your anger on this person.</p>
